MEDFORMS BOOKLETS ARE COPYRIGHTED.

We have registered our booklet templates with the United States Copyright Office, and they recognize them as the intellectual property of MedForms. This is why you will find MedForms' copyright designation on the back cover of each booklet.

MEDFORMS LICENSES THE COPYRIGHTED BOOKLETS FOR YOUR USE.

When you begin doing business with MedForms, your company signs a License Agreement acknowledging that the contents of the booklet are the sole intellectual property of MedForms.

ONLY MEDFORMS CAN PRINT OUR BOOKLETS.


No other person or company can reproduce the booklets for commercial use. This means it is prohibited by law to photocopy, scan, retype or have another printer reproduce the booklet, even if you run out of booklets. This is why MedForms recommends always reordering your booklets 4-6 weeks before you run out.

ARE THERE ANY EXCEPTIONS TO THE LICENSE AGREEMENT?

MedForms explicitly states on the License Agreement that we grant an exception for agencies to reproduce the forms contained in the booklet. We understand that sometimes forms need to be used multiple times over the course of care, or a copy of the form needs to be made for the patient's medical record, so we grant an exception for agencies to reproduce MedForms' copyrighted forms only. The educational portion of the booklet may not be reproduced.

WHAT IF I'D LIKE TO INCLUDE FORMS OR MATERIALS FROM ANOTHER COMPANY IN THE MEDFORMS BOOKLET?

Just as we expect other companies to respect our copyrighted materials, MedForms will not reproduce proprietary and/or copyrighted materials by other companies without their written permission. If you would like to include a copyrighted form or policy in the booklet, we will ask you to reach out to the owner and ask for written permission to include it in your custom MedForms' booklet.
